WHEREAS: Part of Minnesota's greatness lies in its commitment to assisting hearing impaired

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Council for the Hearing Impaired and the Minnesota Department of Human

Service's Deaf Services Division are working with individuals, advocacy groups, and
human service organizations to increase the understanding of the special needs and
abilities of hearing impaired people; and

WHEREAS: Through their efforts, hearing impaired Minnesotans are gaining full and equal service access to education, health, corrections, and jobs and training services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the importance of recognizing hearing impaired Minnesotans.

Further, I urge all Minnesotans to recognize and honor the work of the Minnesota Council for the Hearing Impaired, the Minnesota Department of Human Service's Deaf Services Division with its Regional Service Centers, and all the individuals, agencies and advocates who are working on behalf of Minnesota's hearing impaired citizens.
