WHEREAS: Preserving our state's aesthetic environment and energy efficiency is paramount; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has been a leader in the nation in developing progressive environmental protection programs; and

WHEREAS: It is essential for the residents of Minnesota to develop a conscientious posture in terms of our ecology and how to maintain or improve it; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans generate 4 million tons of solid waste every year, much of which can and should be reduced and recycled; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has consistently established effective programs for the protection of our natural resources and wildlife populations such as the Reinvest in Minnesota (RIM) program; and

WHEREAS: Efforts to perpetuate environmental preservation through active community, individual, and public-private sector involvement should be strongly supported and promoted;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 16-22, 1989 to be
