WHEREAS: The Minnesota Music Academy is presenting the 9th Annual Minnesota Music Awards;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 8-14, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


