WHEREAS: This event coincides with the on-going activities in honor of the City of Moose Lake's 100th Year Anniversary; and


WHEREAS: The Moose Lake School's Media Resource Center will also be dedicated in name as "Minnesota Governors' Media Resource Center" on this special day; and
