



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Pulp, Paper and Allied Support Industry is one of the premier manufacturing segments of Minnesota's economy, and is vital to investment and employment in Greater Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: This industry is the principal user of the resources produced by the 34% of the State of Minnesota which is covered by forests; and

WHEREAS: The Paper Science and Engineering Program at the University of Minnesota has been successful in producing graduates who have secured careers in the state's pulp and paper industry and have contributed to the profitability and success of their companies, and

WHEREAS: The Paper Science and Engineering Council continues to grow as it enters its third year as an industrial support group dedicated to helping the University of Minnesota produce engineers and scientists with training and experience related to their industry; and

WHEREAS: Scholarship funds raised by this council have helped to attract and support Minnesota's students as they prepare for careers in science and engineering fields related to the State's manufacturing industry, helping Minnesota to become the "Brainpower State"; and

WHEREAS: The Council fosters cooperation between the University of Minnesota and the Pulp and Paper Industry to solve common problems in the areas of technology transfer, environmental improvement, efficient utilization of resources, and the optimization necessary to keep us economically competitive; and

WHEREAS: The Council is actively supported by professional societies such as the Paper Industry Management Association, and the Technical Association of the Pulp and Paper Industry;
