WHEREAS: Mrs. Nancy Parkko and Mrs. Anne Gerlovich have each served Nopeming Nursing Home, Duluth, Minnesota as Registered Nurses for more than 30 years; and

WHEREAS: Both Mrs. Parkko and Mrs. Gerlovich have been positive contributors at Nopeming during its days as a Minnesota Tuberculosis Hospital and its evolution to a large skilled nursing home that includes a Special Care Unit for the treatment of persons with Alzheimer's Disease and an Infectious Disease Unit; and
