WHEREAS: Rachel is a Minneapolis native whose parents and uncle still reside in Minneapolis;

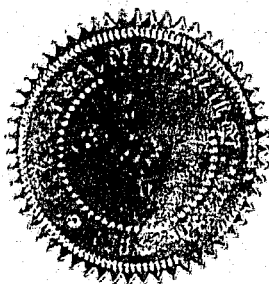
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 14, 1989 to be
