WHEREAS: Northeastern Minnesota is a land rich in natural resources including thousands of splendid lakes, rivers, forests and parks, millions of acres of timber land, valuable iron ore deposits, and abundant talented human resources; and

WHEREAS: The people of Northeastern Minnesota have worked to develop and diversify a strong regional economy; and

WHEREAS: The economy of Northeastern Minnesota has been strengthened by major corporate reinvestment in the mining and timber industries, the development of the tourist industry, and the development of new and expanding businesses in the region; and

WHEREAS: The people of Northeastern Minnesota wish to affirm through their first annual display of "Progress and Innovation" that reinvestment and economic development efforts have brought about positive changes in the region's economy; and

WHEREAS: Northeastern Minnesota is a vital, integral part of the economy of the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, May 2, 1989 to be
