WHEREAS: Tenney is a city in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Tenney is located in west central Minnesota, near the border of North Dakota; and

WHEREAS: The population of Tenney, 13, is the smallest of any city in the State of Minnesota;
and

WHEREAS: No formal proclamation or documentation has hitherto been presented to the town or its inhabitants;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 23, 1989 to be

TENNEY DAY


in Minnesota, in honor of the town, its people and its history.


