



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Jeffrey N. Custer, no known residence, is leaving his position as Radio/TV Coordinator for the DFL Caucus of the Minnesota House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Custer is to be re-employed as Press Secretary to Congressman Tim Penney; and

WHEREAS: The furniture restoration industry in Minnesota is expected to suffer due to Custer's leaving; and

WHEREAS: This setback to the industry will be offset by the continued fine condition of the furnishings of the Governor's Office, State Capitol Building, and State Office Building, saving Minnesota taxpayers a substantial sum of money;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, May 19, 1989 to be
