America's medical research enterprise has been and continues to be a world leader in WHEREAS: promoting health and preventing disease and disability; and

Medical research continuously contributes to the discovery of new knowledge that will WHEREAS: lead to the improved health and well-being of Americans and of all humankind; and

Medical research has fostered a productive and ongoing positive public and private WHEREAS: sector partnership among government, academia, industry, and voluntary organizations in pursuit of research excellence and discovery; and

Medical research has significantly contributed to bringing America's death rate to an all-time low and its life expectancy rates to all-time highs; and WHEREAS:

The many voluntary health agencies comprising the National Health Council have joined together nationally to raise awareness of the importance of medical research, and that much of the promising research takes place right here in the great State of Minnesota; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 11, 1989

in Minnesota.
