WHEREAS: Her dedication to and faith in community make her a shining example of a "Partner in Progress"; and


WHEREAS: She has touched the lives and living spaces of thousands of Minnesotans in her efforts to help them achieve a high quality life;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 29, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


