- WHEREAS: The Sister Kenny Institute provides medical rehabilitation to brain injury victims and is able to provide its patients with love, support and the highest medical care possible; and
- WHEREAS: The Richfield Chapter of Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA) has taken the opportunity to organize a teenage dance to benefit the hospital and its brain injury unit; and
- WHEREAS: The Richfield DECA Chapter should be recognized as an organization which participates in outstanding civic activities; and
