## ORDINANCE NO. 950

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WILLMAR, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF WILLMAR.

WHEREAS, the following described land is owned by the City of Villmar, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, said property abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as to be properly subject to City Government and since annexation thereof will be in the best interests of the City of Willmar and of the territory to be annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, EE IT ORDAINED by the city Council of the City of Willmar as follows:

Section 1. ANNEXATION. The following described property is hereby annexed and included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

## ATPACHED HERETO AS PARCELS I, II AND III.

Section 2. BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY OF WILTMAR. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and the territory affected.

Section 3. ABUTS ON CITY LIMITS. That the property above described abuts on city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to city government.

Section 4. ZONING THE ABOVE AREA. The area above described shali be zoned A-Agricultural, containing 9.15 acres.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Willmar Township, the County Auditor of Kandiyohi County and the Secretary of state of the State of Minnesota, and from and after its adoption and publication.

which lies between two Iines run parallel with and distant 100 feet and 130 feet northwesterly of Line 1 described below:

Line 1. Beginning at a point on the north line of Section 24, Township 119 North, Range 35 West, distant 861.95 feet west of the north quarter corner thereof; thence run southwesterly at an angle of 49 degrees 59 minutes 01 seconds from said north section line (measured from west to south) for 3684.98 feet and there terminating;
