



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Felines have been faithful friends of man throughout the ages; and

WHEREAS: Felines rely on human kindness for their nourishment, health and happiness; and

WHEREAS: More than 8,000,000 abandoned and homeless felines must be cared for by animal shelters every year; and

WHEREAS: The American Humane Association, with the cooperation of Morris the 9 Lives Cat, who himself was found in a shelter, is conducting Adopt-A-Cat month in June to find homes for the nation's homeless felines;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June, 1989 to be

ADOPT-A-CAT MONTH

in Minnesota.
