B'nai B'rith was founded 146 years ago on October 13, 1843, and has been a leader in the field of community and volunteer service; and WHEREAS:

B'nai B'rith was the first international service organization founded in the United States. It established the first free employment bureau in this country and opened numerous manual and technical schools for immigrants; and WHEREAS:

Binal Birith provides one of the world's largest private networks for nonsectarian WHEREAS: low-rent apartment housing for the elderly. It has been a world leader in the battle against prejudice and has steadfastly advocated human rights for all people around the

B'nai B'rith operates the first and largest Jewish youth program in the world, providing eduction, social and leadership skills. It founded and operates the Hillel Foundations, which serve Jewish youth on over 300 college campuses; and WHEREAS:

Binai Birith is active in 42 countries on six continents throughout the free world and serves 500,000 members ranging in age from 13 to 103; and WHEREAS:

Bingi Birith, as the world's largest Jewish Service Organization, unites the Jewish community in dedication to the betterment of the Jewish people, the strengthening of Israel and the preservation of Jewish learning and life around the world; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 1989

in Minnesota in recognition of 146 years of service to the community at large.
