

## Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Donald C. Wick, FIC, RHU, LUTCF, began his career as a Local Representative of AAL in 1962 in the Jack Hylton Agency in Seattle, Washington; and
- WHEREAS: Donald served as a District Representative in Vancouver, Washington from 1963 to June 1968; and
- WHEREAS: Donald was appointed General Agent in Rochester, Minnesota in 1968, and his agency was the top agency in AAL in 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1973; and
- WHEREAS: Donald Was the AAL's General Agent of the Year for those four years, and he also received the AAL Agency Bulder award in 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1973; and
- WHEREAS: In 1977-78, Donald was the first and only fraternal person to hold the office of President of the Minnesota Association of Life Underwriters in its 52 year history; and
- WHEREAS: In March, 1983, Donald was appointed Associate Director of Agencies in the AAL Central Region, and in 1987, he was appointed General Manager for the North Central Region; and
- WHEREAS: Donald retired in from service to AAL in February of 1988; and
- WHEREAS: Donald and his wife Betty have been active in their church and community, and they have eight children;



NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 30, 1989 to be
