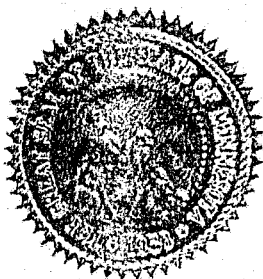

WHEREAS: Joan Higinbotham is completing her four year tenure as President of the League of Women Voters of Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 3rd, 1989 to be


