

Proclamation


- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Air Route Traffic Control Center has been selected as the National En Route Facility of the Year for 1988; and
- WHEREAS: The effectiveness and efficiency of the Minneapolis Center has contributed to public safety and operational efficiency by reducing operational errors by 46%; and
- WHEREAS: Thirteen formal flight assists were handled by control personnel who were instrumental in aiding aircraft in distress; and

- WHEREAS: The effectiveness of the Center assists in fostering aviation which is an important factor to the state and regional economies;



NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week in June to be
