WHEREAS: The Jamboree will establish and promulgate Scouting activities and methods that will find their way into the program of posts, teams and troops across the nation;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of August to be

NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE WEEK


in Minnesota.
