WHEREAS: There is overwhelming evidence that tobacco is destroying the health and shortening the lives of millions of Americans; and

WHEREAS: Cigarette smoking kills 390,000 Americans each year; and

WHEREAS: The U.S. Surgeon General's recent reports state that nicotine is an addictive agent, and that smoking is the single most preventable cause of premature death in our society;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 5, 1989 to be the first annual

NONDEPENDENCE DAY


