WHEREAS: The Old Log Theater begins its historic 50th Season at Excelsior, Minnesota on Wednesday, May 31, 1989;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, May 31, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


