WHEREAS: The St. Paul Derby is held as a benefit for the St. Paul Police, and attracted approximately 15,000 spectators last year; and


WHEREAS: The St. Paul Derby will feature the K.L.M. Nation's Cup, the first international title of its kind;

FOR REINING HORSES


in Minnesota.
