AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF BROWNTON, McLEOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, CERTAIN LAND IN SUMTER TOWNSHIP ABUTTING THE CITY, BEING A PART OF THE AUDITOR'S PLAT OF GOVERNMENT LOT ONE (1), SECTION THIRTY-ONE (31), TOWNSHIP ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN (115) NORTH, RANGE TWENTY-NINE (29) WEST, McLEOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROWNTON DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: The City of Brownton, having received a Petition of Melvin Does, McLeod County Chairman, and Dede Balcom-Lambert, McLeod County Coordinator, on behalf of McLeod County, the owner of certain lands hereinbelow described which abut the present territorial limits of the City of Brownton and the City Council of the City of Brownton desires to annex such lands so as to include said lands within the city limits of Brownton. Such parcel of land is located in Sumter Township, McLeod County, Minnesota, and described as follows, to wit:

That part of Government Lot One (1), Section Thirty-one (31), Township One Hundred Fifteen (115) North, Range Twenty-nine (29) West, McLeod County, Minnesota, described as commencing at the Southeast Corner of Government Lot One (1); thence north assumed bearing, along the east line of said Government Lot One (1), a distance of 802.10 feet; thence west approximately 426 feet to the edge of Lake Addie and the point of beginning; thence east approximately 426 feet to the east line of Government Lot One (1); thence south along the east line of Government Lot One (1) 652.10 feet; thence west 233.00 feet; thence south 13.92 feet; thence west approximately 222 feet to the edge of Lake Addie; thence north along the edge of Lake Addie to the point of beginning.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Brownton do hereby determine that the land described in Section 31 above abutts the present territorial limits of the City of Brownton and is urban in character, and the annexation of said land will be to the best interest of the City of Brownton and the territory affected.

Section 3: Therefore, the lands referred to in Section 31 above and legally described as set forth therein are hereby annexed, added to, and made a part of the City of Brownton, Minnesota, as effectually as

if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4: This Ordiance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Board, McLeod County Auditor, Clerk of Sumter Township, and the Secretary of the State of Minnesota.
