ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WINNEBAGO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or borough; and

WHEREAS, 60 percent or more of the perimeter of this territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character;

The City Council of the City of Winnebago ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Winnebago, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, 60 percent or more of the perimeter of which territory is bordered by territory already included within the City limits:

(See attached Exhibit A)

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, the Town Clerk of the affected township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Population. The population of the annexed territory is 0.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage of publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2 and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
