

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

duly sworn, on oath, says she is and during all the times herein stated has been  
foreman of the printer and the printer in charge of the Winona Area Shopper and  
Post and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows:

(1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and  
in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 1,200 square inches;

(2) Said newspaper is a weekly, distributed at least once each week for 52 weeks  
each year.

(3) Said newspaper in at least half of its issues each year has no more than 75

notices; and in all of its issues each year has 50 percent of its news columns devoted

(4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports  
to serve, and has at least 500 copies regularly distributed without charge to local  
residents;

(5) Said newspaper has its known office of issue established in the county in  
which lies, in whole or in part, the municipality which the newspaper purports to  
serve;

(6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State  
Historical Society;

(6a) Said newspaper is available at single or subscription prices to any person,  
corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the  
newspaper and making the applicable payment, and is distributed without charge to  
local residents;

(7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions of this  
subdivision for at least one year last past;

(8) Said newspaper has published and submitted to the Secretary of State a  
statement of ownership and circulation verified by a recognized independent  
circulation auditing agency.

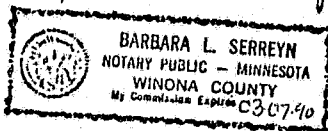




RESOLUTION OF  
WINONA CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION GRANTING FINAL MUNICIPAL APPROVAL TO  
CONSOLIDATION OF THE WINONA FIRE DEPARTMENT RELIEF  
ASSOCIATION WITH THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT  
ASSOCIATION POLICE AND FIRE FUND

WHEREAS, the 1987 Minnesota legislature adopted legislation (Laws 1987, Chapter 296, codified as Chapter 353A of Minnesota Statutes) enabling local police and firefighters relief associations to be voluntarily consolidated with the Public Employees Retirement Association Police and Fire Fund (P.E.R.A.) with the consent of the relief association membership and the approval of the governing body of the affected municipality; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such legislation, the Winona City Council gave its preliminary approval of the 18th day of April, 1989, by resolution 89-76, for the purpose of continuation of the process of considering such consolidation involving the Winona Fire Department Relief Association; and


WHEREAS, all of the actions preliminary to consolidation finalization set forth in Minnesota Statutes 353A.05 have now taken place, in that the City Council has received the actuarial report prepared by the actuary retained by the Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement, and the required reviews by the State Board of Investment and the Public Employees Retirement Association (P.E.R.A.) have taken place; and


WHEREAS, the Winona City Council has today held the public hearing required by Minnesota Statutes 353A.04, subd. 8, and satisfying the requirements for the public hearing set forth in Minnesota Statutes 353A.02, subd. 25; and

WHEREAS, this public hearing was held no later than one month after the conclusion of the actions preliminary to the finalization of the consolidation;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Winona City Council hereby grants its final approval of consolidation of the Winona Fire Department Relief Association with the Public Employees Retirement Association Police and Fire Fund, such consolidation to be effective as of the date to be established for consolidation by the Board of the Public Employees Retirement Association as provided in Minnesota Statutes 353.06.


