WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes the contributions of Adult Day Care in serving those who are vulnerable due to physical and/or mental impairments;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17 through September 23 to be

in Minnesota.


