WHEREAS: After 65 seasons, Cheever Field at Hibbing High School will officially be retired September 8th, 1989; and

WHEREAS: "A Last Hurrah" for Cheever Field will be staged around a game between the Hibbing Bluejackets and the Mesabi East Giants; and

WHEREAS: The ground will be broken after the game to dedicate a new \$4.5 million physical education and music facility; and

WHEREAS: The new facility will require the demolition of Cheever Field, the home to Hibbing athletes since 1924;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

to be officially retired on September 8, 1989.


