



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Protecting the health of Minnesota's people is a complex and challenging task, requiring the committed efforts of professionals from a variety of disciplines; and

WHEREAS: Local public health agencies play a critical role in developing policies that promote cooperation among health professionals and all segments of the community, so they can work together to accomplish the statewide goals of community health services; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's local community health boards are already providing leadership in all 87 counties of the State; and

WHEREAS: Officials representing these local health boards will join other State and local officials, public health professionals and others in the public health community, September 27-29, 1989, at the Community Health Conference in Brainerd; and

WHEREAS: Participants at this conference will explore new ways to "assemble the puzzle" of public health, and develop coordinated strategies for helping Minnesotans avoid preventable disease, injury, disability and death, and lead safe, healthy and satisfying lives;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 24 through 30 to be

in Minnesota.


