WHEREAS: Thanksgiving week is a traditional time to commemorate and observe the important role of families in strengthening America;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 19-25, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


