



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Harold Yates, International Brotherhood of Teamsters General Executive Board Trustee, Teamsters Joint Council 32 Vice President and General Drivers, Helpers and Truck Terminal Employees, Local Union Number 120 President, was born in Cumberland, Wisconsin on August 15, 1934; and
- WHEREAS: Harold Yates has served labor from the time he joined the Teamsters in 1959, when he worked at Admiral Merchants Motor Freight Lines, to the present in his position as President of Teamster Local 120, to which he was elected in 1971; and
- WHEREAS: He served as a representative of Minnesota D.R.I.V.E. from 1965-66, and was elected as Recording Secretary in 1967; and
- WHEREAS: At the state level of Teamsters activity, Harold Yates was elected Trustee of Joint Council 34's Executive Board in 1967, Trustee of Joint Council 32's Executive Board after merging with Joint Council 34, and Vice President in 1985; and
- WHEREAS: Harold Yates was elected as a member of the Teamsters National Master Freight Policy Committee and Trustee of the General Executive Board in June 1989; and
- WHEREAS: Harold Yates served on the Central States Health and Welfare Pension Board as a Trustee from 1977-84, and has served on the Central States Policy Committee since 1984; and
- WHEREAS: Harold Yates is Chairman of the Central States Local Cartage Committee and Chairman of the Minnesota South Dakota State Committee;
