WHEREAS: Persons of Hispanic descent have enriched Minnesota's history through their proud heritage, rich culture and Spanish language;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 17th day of September, 1989 to be

in Minnesota, in honor of the Embajadora Hispana Pageant participants and those associated with making the Pageant a reality.


