WHEREAS: Jesse Overton's leadership has significantly impacted the future and direction of the Minnesota Job Skills Partnership;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, September 20, 1989 to be


