**WHEREAS:** Black music and art of all varieties are outstanding features of Minnesota's arts and entertainment scene; and

**WHEREAS:** Black musicians and educators from the State of Minnesota have contributed many varieties of music to the state, the nation and the world, helping to establish our state as a music and arts center; and

**WHEREAS:** This proclamation and the Minnesota Annual Black Musicians Awards Ceremony express the commitment of the people of the State of Minnesota to honoring the black musicians and educators of our great state;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 18 through 24, 1989 to be**

**MINNESOTA BLACK MUSICIANS AND ARTS WEEK**

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to take note of this occasion.
