WHEREAS: D.A.R.E. is Drug Abuse Resistance Education; and

WHEREAS: D.A.R.E. brings together uniformed law enforcement officers, as teachers, with 5th and 6th grade students, to help these students build the social skills to resist peer pressure to experiment with drugs; and

WHEREAS: D.A.R.E. builds self esteem and self worth in young people and teaches them to say "no" to drugs and alcohol; and

WHEREAS: D.A.R.E. is supported by students, teachers, parents and law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota D.A.R.E. has been active in communities statewide; and

WHEREAS: September 14, 1989 has been proclaimed National D.A.R.E. Day by the U.S. Congress;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 14th day of September to be
