WHEREAS: September 12, 1989 is the one-hundredth day after the massacre in and around Tiananmen Square in Beijing, China; and

WHEREAS: The one-hundredth day after a death is an important milestone in traditional Chinese mourning; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans were particularly saddened by the deaths of the demonstrators in and around Tiananmen Square;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twelfth day of September, 1989 to be

TIANANMEN SQUARE REMEMBRANCE DAY


in Minnesota in honor of those who died for and those who continue to fight for democracy.


