


Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Valerie Jerich has been selected as the Citizen Of The Year by the Minnesota Trial Lawyers Association; and
- WHEREAS: Valerie Jerich launched a personal crusade to assure that legislation was enacted which provides that automobile insurance consumers in Minnesota receive full value for their insurance liability, should they be victims of an automobile accident; and
- WHEREAS: Valerie Jerich has worked for the State of Minnesota since 1983, when she began working in the Constituent Services Division of the Governor's Office; and

in Minnesota.


