WHEREAS: The State Law reflects a comprehensive approach to achieving a balanced workforce; and

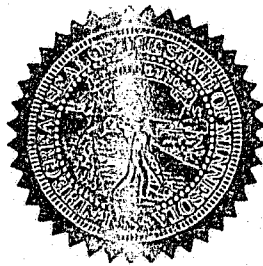
WHEREAS: Affirmative Action in state government allows for the opportunity to represent the
