WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes the value of the unique contributors of its ethnic communities; and

WHEREAS: It is recognized that the collective contribution by these individuals at the state, County, or municipal level benefit the State of Minnesota as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 25, 1989 to be
