



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The New London to New Brighton Antique Car Run began in 1987 during New Brighton, Minnesota's Centennial Year Calendar of events; and
- WHEREAS: The event was a way for New Brighton to reinforce ties to their "namesake city" of Brighton, England; and
- WHEREAS: The event is designed to replicate the prestigious "Commemorative Run" between Brighton and London, England held annually since 1896; and
- WHEREAS: The American version between New London and New Brighton features antique cars from 1908 and earlier, and any one and two cylinder vehicles; and
- WHEREAS: The purpose of the run is to promote the communities of New London and New Brighton; and to create and reinforce the appeal and durability of antique automobiles; and
- WHEREAS: The Run is designed to showcase 120 miles of beautiful Minnesota countryside and to provide drivers and passengers from the United States, England, and Canada a sample of Minnesota hospitality second to none; and
- WHEREAS: The Run has been extremely successful even after only two years because of the dedication of the antique car owners/drivers, the run sponsors, community organizations and volunteers, and of course, Minnesota spectators at the start and finish lines and all along the route; and
- WHEREAS: The Run reinforces that people, especially Minnesotans, enjoy and appreciate veteran automobiles and enjoy celebrating at the Annual New London to New Brighton Antique Car Run;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 21-27, 1989 to be
