WHEREAS: The Army Airforce established the Arctic Training School, as arctic survival techniques were needed World War II; and

WHEREAS: Many key personnel in the Search and Rescue Teams were trained in Arctic Survival; and

WHEREAS: The survival in the Arctic depended on trained personnel in first aid, navigation, dog-sled operation, mountain climbing, survival food and other keys to cold weather living; and

WHEREAS: Specialized instruction in the Alaskan Division of the Airforce Training Command resulted in many lives being saved; and

WHEREAS: The men in this Arctic Survival School served with distinction; and

WHEREAS: This group is meeting in St. Paul on September 13, 1989;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the thirteenth day of September to be

in Minnesota.


