



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: Arnold H. Onstad has devoted boundless time and energy to protect water and land resources in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Arnold promoted conservation tirelessly as a Supervisor on the Root River Soil and Water Conservation District Board for over thirty years; and
- WHEREAS: Arnold's leadership as Chair of the Southern Minnesota Rivers Basin Board for over fifteen years fostered innovations in water management and close cooperation between local, state, and federal governments; and

in Minnesota.


