



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Grand Opening of the Croft Mine Historical Park will take place on Thursday, August 10, 1989; and

WHEREAS: This recreational area on the north edge Crosby, Minnesota is located on the original site of the Croft Underground Mine, and includes a simulated underground mining experience; and

WHEREAS: The original office of Cuyler Adams, founder of the Cuyler Range, was moved from Deerwood, Minnesota to the Croft Mine Historical Park for the public to view; and

WHEREAS: The park also includes an original Crosby house, built by George H. Crosby, the founder of the town, one of many he built as homes for the miners; and

WHEREAS: This park will allow the public to take a step back in time and learn what life in a Minnesota mining town was like in the early 1900's;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 10, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


