- WHEREAS: Dr. Edward L. Segal is a dedicated member of the medical profession who has worked tirelessly to improve the quality of medical care in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: He has been on the teaching staff of the University of Minnesota School of Medicine since 1959; and
- WHEREAS: He served on the Minnesota Medical Alumni Association Board from 1963 to 1973 and is a former president of the association; and
- WHEREAS: He served on the University of Minnesota Medical Foundation Board of Trustees from 1979 to 1987, and the University's Medical Foundation Board Research Grants Committee; and
