



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota 4-H Youth Development is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the 4-H Building at the Minnesota State Fair, dedicated in 1939 by Governor Harold Stassen; and

WHEREAS: A quarter of a million young people have used this learning laboratory during its 50-year history, and about 17 million Minnesotans have visited it during the past 50 State Fairs; and

WHEREAS: The building has been remodeled in 1989 through generous contributions and will be rededicated in a public celebration on Sunday, September 3, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 3, 1989 to be

4-H DAY IN MINNESOTA

in Minnesota.
