



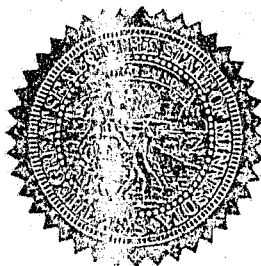
Proclamation
