

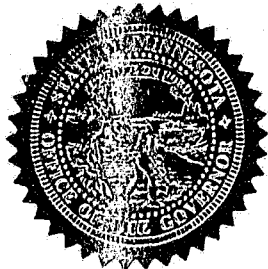


Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Heritagefest, chosen by the Minnesota Department of Tourism as one of Minnesota's top twenty-five festivals, will be celebrating its 15th annual celebration July 13-16, 1989; and
- WHEREAS: Heritagefest is a unique Old World celebration established to promote the city of New Ulm's German heritage; and
- WHEREAS: The 15th annual Heritagefest will be held at 12th North and State Streets in New Ulm, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The Festival includes a wide variety of ethnic entertainment, food, arts and crafts, folklore and a parade, making it an exciting and colorful celebration of history and culture; and
- WHEREAS: Each year performing groups from Europe are included in the entertainment schedule, which also includes dancers, mimes and jugglers; and
- WHEREAS: The Sigi Weber Showband from Waldshut, the Musikverein Herborn-Seelbach youth band and the Musikverein Degerschlacht, from West Germany will be making return visits to the 1989 Heritagefest;
- WHEREAS: All Minnesotans are encouraged to join in celebrating Heritagefest, one of the Upper Midwest's top festivals, which draws people from all over the United States;
