WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is a better place to live due, in part, to Howard's efforts; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 10, 1989 to be

in Minnesota, in acknowledgement and appreciation of Howard F. Grindy as he celebrates his retirement.


