



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Hugh Gallagher is retiring from service with the Communications workers of America (CWA) after 43 years of service; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh Gallagher was born in Scotland, and moved with his family to New York City when he was two years old, where he grew up. He started working for Western Electric in 1946, and was a member of CWA Local 1190; and
- WHEREAS: In April, 1962, Hugh Gallagher became area representative for CWA Local 1190 staff, and in October of that year he was assigned to CWA's office in Minneapolis, where he has happily stayed for the past 27 years; and
- WHEREAS: Hugh has been very active in community and professional activities, including currently serving as President of the Board of the Minneapolis Civil Service Commission, serving as Associate Chair of the Governor's Committee of the Occupational Safety and Health Association from 1971 to 1979, serving as a member of the Board of Directors of Minnesota Blue Cross/Blue Shield from 1967 to 1970, serving as a member of the Board of Directors of St. Mary's Hospital from 1965 to 1968, and serving as a United Way loan executive in 1965; and

- WHEREAS: Hugh's retirement plans include improving his golf game, reading, gardening, working on his home, and getting together with his family; and
- WHEREAS: It is fitting to set aside a day to honor this special man who has served CWA members for over four decades, and has unselfishly given time to serve his community and the State of Minnesota;
