



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Mothers Against Drunk Driving has developed a program entitled "Keep It A Safe Summer," in an effort to make citizens more aware of the dangers of drinking and driving on the roadways and waterways.

WHEREAS: This three month summer safety program promotes personal responsibility through a far reaching public awareness effort.

WHEREAS: Summertime is the most dangerous time for highway deaths, almost half of which are caused by drunken driving, and such tragic waste can be decreased by greater public attention to and avoidance of drunken driving; and

WHEREAS: Mothers Against Drunk Driving knows that we need informed, concerned citizens who are willing to help reduce needless deaths and injuries by taking personal responsibility as hosts and hostesses; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate that all citizens of Minnesota be warned about the deadliness of drunken driving, and drunken boating;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June through Labor Day Weekend to be
